Got DSIRE?

DSIRE, Database of State Incentives for Renewables & Efficiency, is a comprehensive source of information on state, local, utility, and federal incentives and policies that promote renewable energy and energy efficiency.

The DSIRE web site provides information about renewable energy and energy efficiency incentives and policies in effect in the United States. Relevant incentives and policies established by the federal government, state governments, local governments, electric utilities and non-profit organizations are included in DSIRE.

The DSIRE home page features a U.S. map for easy access to incentives and policies available in each state. Clicking a state or territory provides a list of available incentives and policies in that state, organized into two categories: (1) Financial Incentives and (2) Rules, Regulations & Policies.

The list of incentives and policies provides links to individual summaries with the following details:

- The incentive or policy type (e.g., tax credit, rebate program, net metering)
- The implementing sector (e.g., federal, state, utility)
- Eligible sectors (e.g., residential, commercial, government)
- Eligible technologies (e.g., solar water heating, wind energy, insulation)
- Links to authorizing statutes, regulations and relevant legal documents
- A summary of the incentive or policy
- A link to the incentive or policy web site
- Contact information

DSIRE also includes information on federal incentives and policies for renewable energy and energy efficiency technologies, with an emphasis on incentives for end-users.
