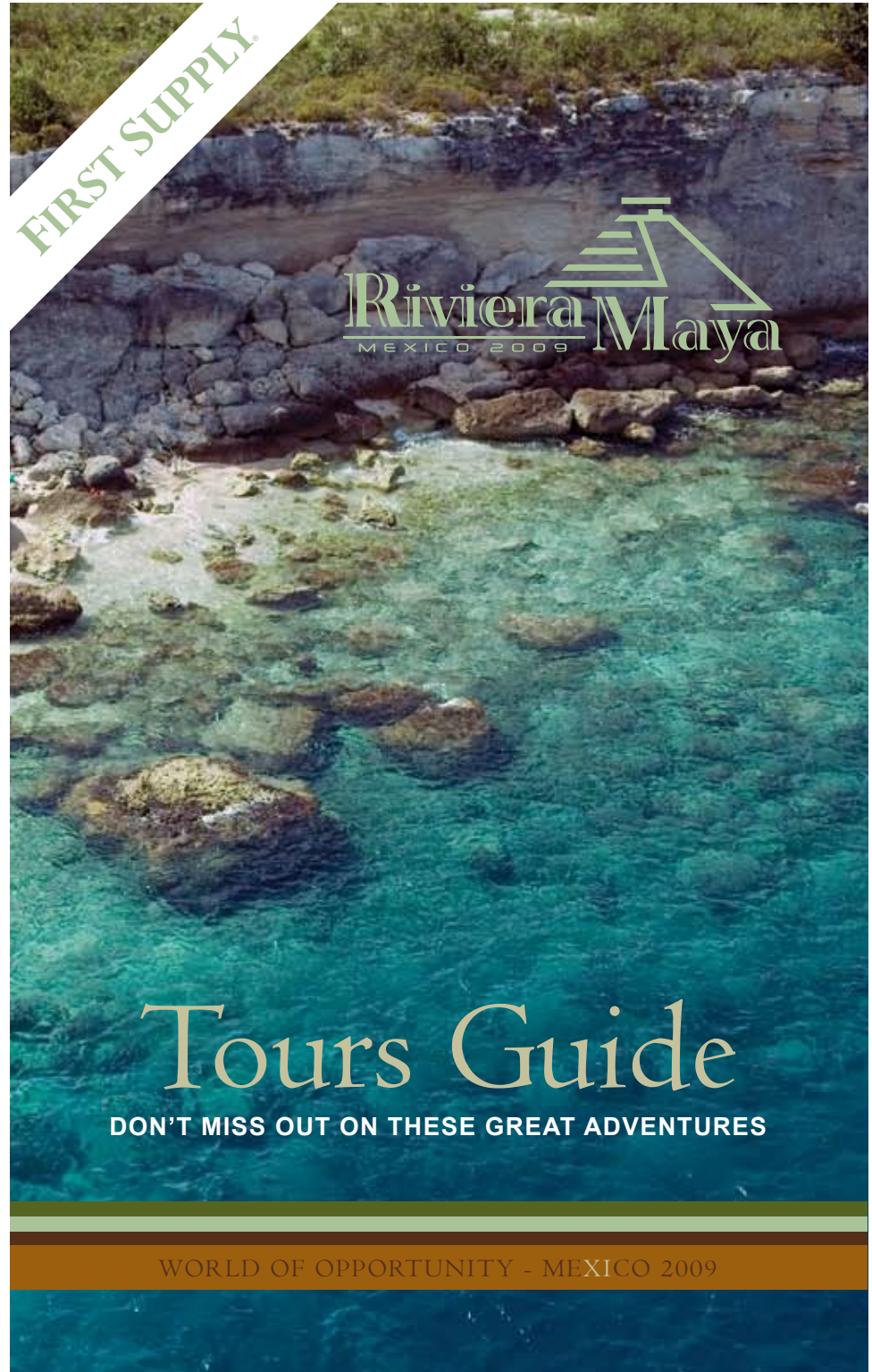

Tulum

The Citadel at Tulum perched atop limestone cliffs and overlooking the rugged turquoise coastline. There are approximately 60 individual structures on this well-restored Post-Classic site, of which the most prominent is El Castillo. The large pyramid-like structure, crowned by a two-room temple, at one time functioned as a lighthouse guiding ships through the treacherous reefs that lie offshore.



Other interesting structures at Tulum include the Temple of the Frescoes which is particularly interesting as it features murals and carved figures in which original pigments are still visible.



Xel-Ha

The aquatic sanctuary fed simultaneously by subterranean freshwater springs and mixed with Caribbean seawater, is reserved for breeding countless species of colorful tropical fish. Restaurants, gift shops, rental facilities, changing rooms with lockers make your visit more convenient & pleasurable.

Recommendations: Wear comfortable shoes and clothing including bathing suit. Bring a camera and lots of film.

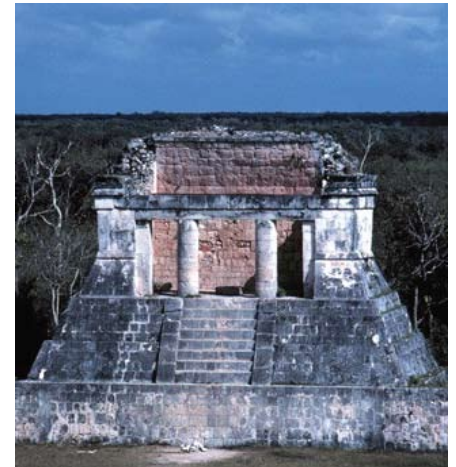
Chichen Itza

ONE OF THE NEW 7 WONDERS OF THE WORLD!

Chichen Itza

Chichen Itza was Founded in 445 AD. The city is divided into two areas: Old Chichen Itza, built between AD 600 and 900; and New Chichen, constructed in the 10th century. The pyramid of Kukulcan is undoubtedly the most impressive structure at Chichen Itza: rising over 90 feet including the Jaguar Shrine.

The imposing pyramid is the site of a remarkable event: every equinox (21-22 March and September) the play of light and shadow on the north staircase of the pyramid gives the illusion a descending serpent— Kukulcan. Other important structures include: the Sacred Sacrificial Well, the Ball Court, the largest of its kind in the Americas; the Temple of the Warriors and the Observatory.



Recommendations: Wear comfortable shoes and casual clothes, including bathing suit, towel, hat and camera. Shopping may be also accessible; guests should bring cash for shopping opportunities.
