Good to Know ... Don't Forget

Hello World Travelers!

How time flies, in just a couple short months we'll find ourselves in beautiful Maui. It's hard to believe soon we'll be soaking up the sun on a relaxing beach while the snow flies in the Midwest. Sandy beaches, Sunny Days, No Responsibilities and No Worries.

As a reminder and for those joining us for the first time; here is some information that's good to know.

- **Passports are NOT required.** A photo ID is required: driver's license, passport or military ID.
- **Checked luggage allowance is two pieces per person (50lbs each)**
 - Early arrival to the airport is especially necessary due to luggage fees. You will need to pay the luggage fee prior to checking bags and this will add to the check in time. Luggage policy varies by airline. Once you receive your tickets you will be able to check the website to get detailed information about your specific airline.
 - Carry-on guidelines are crucial. Airlines are double checking carry-on baggage to make sure that it doesn't exceed the maximum of 45 linear inches and 40 pounds.
- Most airlines charge additional for food and beverages during the flight. You are allowed to pack snacks in your carry-on. Your best option would be dry food sealed in the original container. Beverages must be purchased after clearing security.
- There are several exciting golf courses near by but remember golf clubs are considered one of your checked luggage. Consider renting clubs.
- Resort Casual Attire is suggested for First Supply DineArounds although some restaurants may require long pants.
- Dining options are plentiful and offer an expansive variety.
- Hyatt Regency Maui Resort & Spa serves Pepsi products.
- Telephone calls placed from your room phone will be charged resort rates. Check with your wireless carrier about coverage plans to avoid roaming charges.
- Complimentary WIFI is available in the resort lobby and other common areas. Guest rooms offer dataports and will incur a usage charge for internet access. The business center has additional services available for a fee.
- Airline tickets will be mailed approximately 2-3 weeks prior to departure.
- Gifts are always fun. You will receive an exciting gift package upon arrival in Maui.
- Smoking is not allowed in public buildings in Hawaii. You must be at least 15 feet from the building entrance. The resort has limited designated smoking areas.

If you haven't had the opportunity to return the Optional Tours form; do so by December 1. Even if you choose to only attend the complimentary tour; return the form so we have an accurate count. If you have misplaced the form - visit wootrips.com to download another copy.
