

The Beautiful Island of Maui – Complimentary Island Tour

Saturday, January 29th | Friday, February 4th

The journey begins traveling across the Pali-coastline with spectacular ocean cliff views and head to 'Iao Valley State Park. 'Iao Valley is rich in history and beauty. Take the short hike up to the 'Iao Needle and learn of the legendary battle fought here to unite the islands.

Your adventure continues to the Maui Tropical Plantation; a 60 acre working plantation where you will discover Maui's rich agricultural history. Stroll around or take a fully narrated tram tour to see Sugarcane, Coffee, Macadamia Nuts, Pineapple, Papaya, Mango, Guava & Banana.

Next off to the bustling little fishing village of Lahaina. Lahaina is a lovely and picturesque city full of life and brimming with history with a variety of shops, art galleries and restaurants.

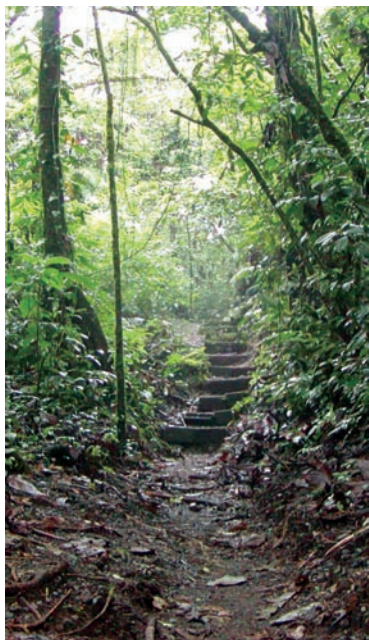

Rain Forest and Waterfall Guided Hike

Sunday January 30th | Saturday February 5th

The guided hike will take you deep into tropical Maui along a natural stream that winds through a lush, forested valley. You will hike through bamboo forests, see tropical ferns, wild vegetation and pass by ancient Hawaiian gardens now covered with tropical fruit and nut trees. The hike is into isolated rainforests where you will find the terrain to be rocky dirt trails that cross over streams several times and is approximately 2-3 miles.

The journey takes you to several small pools beneath ten- and thirty-foot waterfalls where you can swim and enjoy a picnic lunch before the return hike. Tours include lunch, water, water shoes, daypacks, rainwear and mosquito repellent. Please bring swimsuit, sunscreen, hat, etc.

Whale Watch / Snorkeling via Ocean Raft

Monday, January 31st | Monday, February 7th

Join us aboard a 30ft. hard-bottom inflatable raft. Enjoy comfortable seating and spectacular views of Maui's gentle giants from the best seats in town.

The Humpback Whale returns to the warm Hawaiian waters every year during the winter months of December through April for their mating and calving season. The majority of them find their home in the calm waters around the island of Maui. These hard-bottom inflatable rafts are the ideal way to get that up close and eye level photo you have dreamed of.

This trip includes a full narration of interesting whale and Maui facts by our captain and crew, hydrophone and cold drinks and snorkel equipment. Please bring your swimsuit, sunscreen, camera, hat, etc.

Zip Lines – Ka'anapali

Tuesday, February 1st | Tuesday, February 8th

This land steeped in legend, with panoramic views, plunging cliffs, and lush valleys, plays host to a zipline adventure unlike any other in the world. The adventure begins with an exciting 6-wheel drive Pinzgauer ride deep into the rugged and beautiful lands above Ka'anapali.

Eight amazing ziplines allow you to soar high above streams and waterfalls as you experience this piece of wild Hawaii. Learn about Maui's rich history and biological diversity. Overlooking the Kingdom of Hawaii's former Capitol, you will experience a perspective that takes you back in time. See the islands as you never have before . . . and take part in what is being called "Hawaii's best all-around adventure."

Closed toe shoes and long pants required. Must be between 80 and 260 lbs. No refunds are given if weight restriction is not met; scales are at check in location. Please bring camera, sunscreen, etc. There will be two departures on this day.
