According to a recent article, Builder confidence in the market for newly built, single-family homes improved significantly in April. The HMI's component gauging current sales conditions rose by five points to 20 - the strongest gain in that index since 2003 - while the component gauging traffic of prospective buyers rose a solid four points, to 14. The Midwest registered substantial HMI gains in April, rising five points to 15.

For the first time since 2006, home improvement spending is on the upswing. Annual growth will be nearly 5% in 2010, and all signs suggest that the positive trend will continue in 2011, according to the latest Leading Indicator of Remodeling Activity (LIRA), released mid-April by the Remodeling Futures Program at the Joint Center for Housing Studies of Harvard University.
